Infants Worksheets (K-2) \$3.30 + \$2.75 postage Includes outline masters of native and exotic animals and a number of activities including animal coverings, animal features, simple activities about native birds and animals.

Wet & Dry Environments (K-2) \$1.10 + \$1.10 postage HSIE Stage 1 ES S1.6 Identifies and describes ways people and other living things depend upon the Earth and its environments.

What's Alive - Stage I \$3.30 + \$2.75 postage This resource is designed specifically for use at Taronga Western Plains Zoo. It contains background information to assist teachers in developing pre and post zoo activities to complement to zoo excursion, increasing student observation and recording skills in an enjoyable and visibly stimulating environment while meeting syllabus outcomes.

A Change for the Better (Yrs 3-6) \$3.30 + \$2.75 postage This resource is designed to supplement the unit of work 'A Change for the Better' in the NSW Science & Technology K-6 Syllabus (p. 134) and the NSW Science and Technology K-6 Outcomes and Indicators (2000). It investigates adaptations animals have made over a long period of time to better suit their environments. It contains pre-excursion, excursion and post-excursion activities that should be modified to suit your student and programming needs.

Mini Beasts (Yrs 3/4) Postage \$3.30 + \$2.75 postage This resource is designed to supplement the unit of work 'Mini Worlds' in the NSW Science and Technology K-6 Syllabus (P. 192) and the NSW Science and Technology K-6 Outcomes and Indicators (2000). It investigates the interactions between mini-beasts and their habitats, and is written to enhance student observation, recording and reporting skills. It contains pre-excursion and post-excursion activities.

Primary Worksheets (Yrs 3-6) \$3.30 + \$2.75 postage Activities for use before, during and after a zoo excursion. Sample worksheets include Baby Animals, African Animals, Australian Animals, Safari Around the World and Maths Safari.

Shelters – Stage I \$3.30 + \$2.75 postage Integrated Unit including HSIE, ENS, Creative Arts, PDHPE, English, Science & Technology, Mathematics and Data activities and outcomes.

Threatened Australian Animals (K-12) \$3.30 + \$2.75 postage An interesting booklet on endangered Australian animals at Taronga Western Plains Zoo. Includes activities.

Language Worksheets (Yrs 3-8) \$3.30 + \$2.75 postage Worksheets include observation and language development activities under the following titles;

1. Observation Activities
2. Wonderword
3. Creative Writing Exercise
4. Animals and Their Young
5. Collective Nouns

Endangered Species Trail (Yrs 5-8) \$3.30 + \$2.75 postage Included background notes and fact sheets on endangered species and activities relating to many of the endangered species, both native and exotic, around the zoo.

Design & Technology at Taronga Western Plains Zoo (Yrs 7-8) \$3.30 + \$2.75 postage This resource includes activities to be done at Taronga Western Plains Zoo as part of an excursion, plus preparation work before the visit, and follow-up activities which can be done back at school

African Savannah (Yrs 7-9) \$2.20 + \$1.10 postage Contains information on the African Savannah region and worksheets for students to complete at the Zoo. These are appropriate for junior secondary students.

Classification and Adaptation (Science – Stage 4) \$3.30 + \$2.75 Postage Contains a number of activities for use when at Taronga Western Plains Zoo, eg Key Construction, Adaptations and Classification of various species.

Taronga Western Plains Zoo Wetlands Primary (Yrs 3-6) \$6.60 + \$2.75 postage This Wetlands resource is aimed at junior and senior primary school students utilising the Wetlands at Taronga Western Plains Zoo. The information can be adapted for use at any wetland area and is free to photocopy for school use only. This resource has background notes and activities to be done at school or at any wetland and includes a map of Taronga Western Plains Zoo showing water bodies.

Taronga Western Plains Zoo Wetlands Secondary (Yrs 7-10) \$13.20 + \$2.75 postage This Wetland resource is aimed at High School Science, Geography and Agriculture students utilising the Wetlands at Taronga Western Plains Zoo, includes coloured identification charts and maps. The information can be adapted for use at any wetland area and is free to photocopy for school use only. The resource includes background notes and activities to be done at school or at any wetland.

Primates at Taronga Western Plains Zoo (Yrs 11-12) \$2.75 postage This unit concentrates on the non-human primates and the classification of these primates. It may be a useful resource to the study of the Human Species, Classification and the Species Concept and Diversity and Evolution.

Frog Crate (K-6) Comprehensive facts about everything you ever wanted to know about frogs, includes giant floor jigsaw puzzle, activity sheets, lifecycle game, big books, hand puppets, finger puppets, frog identification information and craft ideas. Also has information on how to create a frog habitat in your school or garden.

Literacy Crate (Yrs K-2) Contains a Zoo Animals CD ROM, a mega floor puzzle, fun felt creations of animals, finger puppets and a huge range of books.
